

YOUR GUIDE TO PRAYING FOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS



1 Timothy 2:1-5; 8

I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone—for kings, and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus...I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing.

HOW TO PRAY FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS:

1. Pray They Would Know Jesus and Walk With Him

Lord, we lift up to you each one of our elected officials and appointed officials. We ask for the Holy Spirit to move upon the hearts of every person serving in our government who doesn't have a personal relationship with you, that they would come to know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. And we also lift up to you all those who know you Lord, and we pray they would walk with you daily as they govern our nation.
