

Dear Pastor,

When Christians vote, biblical values win.

About two thirds of your congregation will heed God's call to be salt and light (Matthew 5:13–14) by voting according to biblical principles in the midterm elections this Tuesday.

Tragically, about a third of them won't. They will miss their opportunity to make a difference by staying home on election day. But you can change that.

Move your people from the pews to the polls by participating in My Faith Votes Sunday on November 6. My Faith Votes Sunday is a day when churches across America commit to vote for biblical values in the midterm elections.

You can participate with three simple steps.

1. **Play a video** - During your worship service(s) Sunday, November 6, play the [“Do Good. Go Vote.”](#) video.
2. **Ask for a commitment** – After the video, ask the people in your congregation to commit to voting according to their faith in the election on November 8.
